Legislative Alert!

Please note that the following bills and concurrent resolutions have not been scheduled for a hearing yet.

The deadline for the bills to pass out of the first committee is Thurs., Feb. 11.

We would appreciate if you would kindly encourage your membership to email Committee Chair Ken Ito ([repito@capitol.hawaii.gov](mailto:repito@capitol.hawaii.gov)) or call him (586-8470) and request that a hearing be scheduled as soon as possible.

The bills that require hearings are:

**HB2244: Relating to Surface Water: Natural Springs.**

Prohibits the obstruction of water flow from natural springs

**HB2246: Relating to Marine Life Conservation Districts.**

Prohibits the installation of buoys and moorings and the use of illegal buoys and moorings in Marine Life Conservation Districts.

**HB2483: Relating to Sharks.**

Requires DLNR to adopt rules for the development and placement of signs notifying the public of laws prohibiting the feeding of sharks.

**HB2484: Relating to historic preservation.**

Establishes fines for the knowing destruction of heiau on private lands.

**HB2703: Relating to damage to a place of burial.**

Makes it unlawful to negligently or intentionally cause damage to a place of burial.

**HB2840: Relating to historic preservation.**

Requires a landowner or developer to obtain the written concurrence of the State Historic Preservation Division and conduct a public meeting for any draft mitigation plans prior to obtaining a permit or other approval.

**HCR50: Requesting the auditor to conduct a management audit of the State Historic Preservation Division of the Department of Land and Natural Resources.**
