Essential duties and responsibilities

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Teach physics at high school level.

Instruct students using a wide range of student centered teaching / learning strategies, covering core concepts and skilled as set out in the science department's scope and sequence, in accordance with the school's vision.

Prepare lesson plans following curriculum guidelines set by the department and by the school.

Update the physics curriculum guides on the school wide ATLAS program

Set assignments and correct homework. Post homework assignments weekly on the Internet using the school's Edline program.

Prepare and administer assessments to evaluate students' progress; record results electronically and post student grades electronically on a weekly basis.

Maintain discipline in the classroom.

Participate in faculty and departmental meetings and attend teacher training workshops and educational conferences.

Carry out all home room responsibilities.

Determine budget needs and purchase equipment for all physics courses.
